2023 THEME - TIDES

As the Animalia rise from the desert sea we offer the opportunity to ride out the ebbs and flows via our community Coracle. Water is powerful, tides constant. When the water and shore meet, the transitions happen. Treasures unearthed, brought to shore, or buried and carried away. It's nature and it's powerful. May the tides brings us comfort, joy and magic as we all gather to celebrate the changes we continue to experience in our journey forward.





VENUE: SHAKORI HILLS COMMUNITY ARTS CENTER

We returned to Shakori Hills Community Arts Center in Pittsboro, North Carolina, for our third time. This is significant for three main reasons:

- * Being at a public venue, rather than a private residence means greater involvement and permitting requirements from Chatham County.
- * We see ourselves staying at Shakori Hills Community Arts Center and growing into the space, which has a capacity for 5000+ participants.
- * Shakori Hills Community Arts Center provides support and has a willingness to help us best utilize the venue as we grow. We have used about $\frac{1}{3}$ of the property.



CIVIC RESPONSIBILITY

Coracle is a small population and we encourage our participants to embrace radical self-reliance. At the same time, the organizing team was prepared to ensure the safety of the event.

- * The Chatham County Fire Marshall evaluated the safety of our sculpture burn and theme camp flame effects; after inspection, all were permitted for the event.
- * Producers had a 6-hour 'shift' each day beginning on Friday morning where we were responsible, and on-call by radio.
- * Arise Event Services, LLC (AES) was on duty and provided medical and security services by licensed and experienced staff with a centrally located medical station. Their staff was on radio for the entirety of the contracted event. For any and all situations that required more than basic First Aid care, AES was contracted to serve as liaisons with local EMS, as necessary. Thankfully, this was not necessary!

GUARDIAN OF THE SEVEN

Guardian of the Seven is an 8 foot tall lighthouse inspired art piece by Jason Lenhardt and Cory Allison, nods to both the seven seas and the seven chakras. It features seven sides, each containing a multi-layer cnc cut plywood panel representing one of the chakras. At night the lighthouse will be internally illuminated with an array of changing colors and by day it will capture the sun to create an ever changing pattern of shadows and light upon the surrounding earth.

Visitors were encouraged to write messages on the surrounding waves or place memorial objects behind the waves prior to the burn.

The sculpture was ignited on schedule and how the artist had planned and envisioned. The Fire Art Safety Team (FAST) organized a perimeter circle. There was an amazing Fire Conclave with several Fire Performers, followed by a safe and beautiful sculpture burn.





ART INSTALLATIONS

- *LAMP LIGHTS: Lamps to light our city.
- *CRITTERZ: A small group of happy hanging hearts and eyes.
- *CARDBOARD SEA FORT BUILDING: Come build the "Sea Fort" a temporary structure in which to imagine your wildest adventures. Constructed from cardboard using kid friendly tools, kid led activity, adults welcome to assist/supervise. 11am Saturday - Ongoing
- *FOUNTAIN OF SUSPENDED DISBELIEF: A tall, thin minimalist structure vaguely reminiscent of an hourglass with stream of water droplets appearing to be suspended in space, or to slowly float upwards or downwards based on position of a control knob. It will run at night for the best illusion.





ART INSTALLATIONS

- *WINDOWS OF THE SOUL: Painted and lighted windows illuminate throughout Coracle.
- *ONLY ONE WAY OUT: An LED lit vertical pinball type game where the player controls a ball balanced on a bar with the aim of getting the ball in the correct hole without getting it in any of the incorrect ones.
- *DECOMMODIFICATION STATION: Stop in, discover an array of supplies dedicated to the practice of removing logos and covering letters. Words are noise, embrace the aesthetic of silence.

*SHAMANIC DRUM JOURNEYING/ SOUND BATH: A drum assisted sound bath. A way of divin-



- *GROOVE GROVE: Convivial Conversations in the Chill Dome, Daytime Dancing, Fun Spaces for Kids and Adults, and some Special Community Meals.



NEW! OFF-CENTER CAMP

The venue has a shack structure conveniently located close to restrooms, drinking water, electricity, first aid & safety. Previous years we provided beverages.

This year we expanded "Coracle Coffee" to call it "Off-Center Camp" to add an official information center and lounge area.

Evening and afternoon volunteers had the opportunity to host a mini activity during their block and were referred to as Off-Center Camp Hosts. Host's activities combined to create spontaneously beautiful happenings!

COFFEE, TEA & HOT COCOA OH MY

We provided coffee, hot water & tea from around 7:00 am - 1:30 am daily. The onsite refrigerator was especially helpful to keep creamers cold without the need for a lot of ice.

Hot water was also used to take back to camps for soups and oth-

er meal prep, as hot water bottles to carry in pockets, or just for drinking.

Turmeric was the most popular flavor of tea; there were many requests for more after it ran out.

NEW! INFORMATION CENTER

A dedicated area housed information for participants as a central gathering point:

- * Map of the grounds & camps
- * Schedules & descriptions of activities & theme camps
- * Volunteer signups & information
- * MOOP bags & composting
- * Weather radio & condoms
- * Lost & Found
- * Served as a meeting spot for some volunteer teams

NEW! OFF-CENTER LOUNGE

We added a lounge area with picnic tables and a 10x20 shelter!

The lounge area provided an enclosed and heated retreat during the weekend's cold hours & doubled as a place to hold scheduled and spontaneous events.

At various times, volunteers held events in the space, such as: massage therapy, games, jokes, financial advice, sacred geometry, Harry Potter themed drinks, buffer massages, late evening banjo music, and Pi Camp served delicious pie after the burn in exchange for answering a math question.

The space gave many participants the opportunity to lead an activity for a short time without having to plan a weekend of activities and the associated need for infrastructure, lights, etc.

Off-Center Camp is now ingrained in the Coracle culture and will continue in the coming years!



VOLUNTEERING

Silver and Moni Wack, co-leads on the Volunteer Team took us to the next level with transitioning pre-event volunteer shifts online for all department via signup.com.

Silver set up the database and Moni wrangled & recruited volunteers & leads. They worked with each team lead to identify names and descriptions of shifts and how many were needed.

Signup shifts were also available on-site at Off-Center Camp for folks not signing up in advance.

...not including our Leadership Team of 15. Our takeaway is we did a good job of asking for the right number of people, had pretty good signups, and we staffed the necessary functions of the event. This year's volunteer structure will be a good guide for next year.

If the event should approach 400 participants, we may consider adding Rangers to the volunteer teams.

LEADERSHIP LEARNINGS

What Worked & What We'll Do Differently Next Year

GENERAL SUMMARY

Of the 14 camps present 9 were new to Coracle. All 7 Art installations were new to Coracle. The event duration was increased one more night in 2023. We are happy with the growth level we set in terms of participants and camps this year and plan a steady and slow growth curve in the years to come. The venue imposed a sound policy which meant to turn off all the amplified sounds by midnight and have 'quiet hours' during the event. We were pleasantly surprised how the community responded enthusiastically with the new sound policy. The music cut off request was respected by all the camps playing amplifying sound. This was also the first year we had 'Silent Disco' which was very well received, especially in the quiet hours.

CAMP PLACEMENT

The new sound camp requirements requested by the venue were implemented. The sound camps were placed strategically to cause minimum disturbance to the neighbors.

ONSITE MEDICAL SERVICES

We were committed to our resolution of bringing hired medical support for having a safe Coracle. This year we hired Arise Event Services, LLC (AES). There was a medical station operated by AES located near the permanent bathrooms centrally located. AES also provided medical and security services by licensed and experienced staff. For any and all situations that required more than basic First Aid care, AES was contracted to serve as liaisons with local EMS and authorities, as necessary. We contracted AES to be at the gate during the night time hours which was a big relief to the team and participants.

PRIORITIES FOR NEXT YEAR

- * In 2023, we increased the event duration by 1 night.
- * In 2024, we are planning to add one more night to the event duration, contributing to our slow and steady growth.
- * Parking, Gate and Greeters teams have decided to operate together as a 'Front End Team'. Having a floater position will reduce the amount of volunteers needed.
- * Growing the Coracle Leadership team and adding co-leads to each team.
- * Having a plan to manage the walkie-talkies and requiring signing in and out for each use.
- * We intend to stay in touch about a sound plan with the participants, Arise team and theme camp leads, to address the neighbors' concerns about sound and to adhere to sound permit requirements after 11:45pm.
- * Looking for a new ticketing platform, starting the ticketing process earlier.



LEAVE NO TRACE

The central Off-Center Camp was equipped with moop bags (Matter Out of Place). Participants were encouraged to practice LNT. A compost bin was available at the Off-Center Camp. All the coffee grounds generated from Off-Center Camp were composted.

Few bags of trash was removed from the property. Volunteers swept every area of the property which Coracle used.

The sculpture was placed on a raised platform to protect the soil. All fires were elevated with the exception of an existing fire pit maintained by the venue.

Most participants took serious responsibility for Leave No Trace and were excited to improve the property. The venue was left in a better condition; property representatives expressed that they were very pleased with the conditions.

TICKETING

This was our second year working with Burnertickets.com as our ticketing platform. Our learnings from last year helped us make sure that ticketing this year went smoothly. Burnertickets.com is not functional anymore and we are actively looking for a new ticketing platform for Coracle 2024.

2023 DONATIONS

Coracle donated \$1,000 of earnings, split between three non-profits. \$400 to Burning Man Project, \$400 to Nomad Harvest water-based art, and \$200 to Carolina Common Enterprise, who assists individuals and communities — particularly those in low income and socially disadvantaged rural and urban areas — to create, expand and improve community-based enterprises..
